Background: Joe McDonald of Full Service Concessions, Inc has done an excellent job operating the borough snack bar through a seasonal licensing agreement. I have received very few complaints from patrons regarding pricing, most of which can be attributed to a mistake on the posted menu signage. Joe

has also made every effort to help the Wyomissing Recreation Department in providing additional vendors for events (Scott's Artisan Pizza for July 25 playground carnival) and catering borough events (staff lunch for July 22 borough pool party and August 2 playground prom).

b. End-of-season swimming pool hours:

The pool will be open from 12pm to 7pm, beginning on August 7th. The pool will operate continuously from August 7 to August 27, from 12pm to 7pm daily. The pool will close on Monday, August 28 through Friday, September 1, and reopen for Labor Day weekend September 2 through September 4, from 12pm to 7pm. The pool will close for the season on Tuesday, September 5th.
