- 9) 1725 Dauphin Avenue – Appeal of Stormwater Management Ordinance Violation Notice

- 10) Woodland Road Manhole
- a) Council approved up to \$50,000 to repair the manhole on Woodland Road at their August meeting
- b) Due to utilities located in close proximity to the manhole the repair may now take an extra day and exceed \$50,000 in cost
- A motion is needed to approve, table or deny recommending Council approve repairing the manhole on Woodland Road, at a cost not to exceed \$60,000
