BOROUGH OF WYOMISSING REFUSE & RECYCLING NEWS 2024

As we move into 2024, J.P. Mascaro will continue to be the refuse, recycling, and yard waste hauler. Refuse and recycling weekly Borough-wide collection schedules will remain the same. The hauler reminds residents to clearly label all recycling containers with the recycling insignia or simply write "recycling" on your receptacle. Recyclables in an unmarked container will not be accepted. Residents are encouraged to rinse out soiled containers before recycling as to eliminate excess contamination. Heavily soiled items such as greasy cardboard or other heavily soiled recyclable items, should not be placed with your weekly recycling. Recycling receptacles should be used for recycling only, not yard waste. Yard waste in a labeled recycling container, will not be accepted. Yard waste should be in a separate container or brown yard waste bag for weekly collections between March and December

REFUSE, RECYCLING, AND YARD WASTE REMINDERS:

- Recycling shall not be placed at curb or alley for collection earlier than noon (12:00 p.m.) on the day prior to scheduled collection without specific permission from the Borough.
- Refuse containers shall be removed from the curb or alley by 11:59 p.m. (prevailing time) the same day as collection without specific permission from the Borough and stored on the property to which the refuse containers are related. Containers are not to remain in the alleys or on the streets where they are placed for collection, rather must be moved back to your private property.
- Any content that spills out of your refuse, recycling and/or yard waste containers is the homeowners responsibility to clean up.
- Make sure items are placed in a location visible to the haulers.
- Recycling is single-stream which means residents do not need to sort items. Please do not bag your recyclables.
- Review the list of new recyclable items that are now accepted as part of the Flexible Plastic Packaging Program; please remember to thoroughly clean out your items before recycling.
- Recycling containers must be clearly marked that they are for recycling. Recycling indicator stickers are available at Borough Hall. (The hauler will not accept items in plastic bags.)
- DEP requires that mattresses and box springs must be bagged in mattress disposal bags
- Electronics are not accepted as part of bulk waste, and must be taken to an electronics recycling facility
- Biodegradable paper yard waste bags or refuse type containers without lids are acceptable for yard waste. Yard waste bags can be purchased at Borough Hall, or a home improvement store. (The hauler will not accept items in plastic bags.)
- Yard waste bags or containers should not exceed 40 pounds.
- Yard waste bags should not be placed in gutters if rain is expected.
- Branches should be 6" in diameter or less, and less than 4' in length.
- Residents are limited to 10 bundles of yard waste per week.
- Firewood, stumps, dirt or rocks are not considered yard waste.
- Never mix trash and yard waste.
- If you have a grassy area between your curb and sidewalk, please place your refuse and recycling receptacles there. Placing items on the street makes street sweeping and leaf collections challenging.

Single Stream recycling material can be placed together in the same recycling container

2024 Annual Spring Cleanup will be May 6-May 10 on your scheduled trash day.

Yard Waste pickup is Monday (March-December),
Recycling pickup is Wednesdays
(Unless noted in the holiday schedule below.)

Thursday, November 23, 2023 - Thanksgiving Day

Thursday trash pickup moves to Friday, Friday trash pickup moves to Saturday

Mondays, December 25, 2023 - Christmas Day | January 1, 2024 - New Year's Day May 27, 2024 - Memorial Day | September 2, 2024- Labor Day

Monday trash pickup and yard waste (in season) moves to Tuesday
Tuesday trash pickup and yard waste (in season) moves to Wednesday
Recycling moves to Thursday
Thursday trash pickup and yard waste (in season) moves to Friday
Friday trash pickup and yard waste (in season) moves to Saturday

Thursdays, July 4, 2024 - Independence Day | November 28, 2024 - Thanksgiving Day

Monday trash and yard waste pick up will remain unchanged
Tuesday trash pick will remain unchanged
Wednesday recycling will remain unchanged
Thursday trash pick up moves to Friday
Friday trash pick up moved to Saturday

Wednesdays, December 25, 2024 - Christmas Day | January 1, 2025 - New Year's Day

Monday and Tuesday trash pick up will remain unchanged
Wednesday recycling will move to Thursday
Thursday trash pick up will move to Friday
