3. Water System
  - A. PA American rate increase
  - B. State Hill & Vista Road - Penn DOT Condition Diagram need authorization to execute applications and plans because permit needs to be in Borough name. Solicitor should determine if we need and financial surety or agreement with PA American to ensure the work is completed correctly.
4. Sewers
  - A. I&I
    - Education Letter to Residents
5. Streets
  - A. Bike Route Markings
    - No bidders, so appended to 4<sup>th</sup> Street Extension bid
  - B. 4<sup>th</sup> Street Extension/Multi-Modal - Tower Health
    - A conceptual cost estimate (\$4 million) was prepared including the Borough-wide bike route.
    - DCED Awarded \$2 Million grant for the project.
    - PADOT should announce MTF grant recipients months ago waiting for announcement with COVID-19.
    - Separate from the PennDOT MTF grant, PennDOT has provided \$187,022 in funding to complete the bike route and install bike share stations in Wyomissing and West Reading
    - Need Abouseif and Equus Right-of-Way
    - Opening extended to May 29
6. Green Light Go (2019)
  - PennDOT Grant is for \$173,995 for LED replacements and other upgrades at 29 intersections.
  - Construction must be complete by May 15, 2022; the expiration is June 30, 2022.

- TPD is working on design and permitting.
7. Green Light Go (2020)
    - McCarthy Engineering submitted the application on January 8 for a request of \$420,384 (of \$525,480 total).
  8. Hydrant Requirements – Building Code/Borough Ordinance Amendment
    - The SALDO amendment was adopted at the March Council meeting. The UCC meeting was tabled at the request of a representative on behalf of the Builder’s Association to allow the association time to review and comment on the amendment
  9. Public Works Facility
    - Work continues to develop a long-range master plan for the public works facility
    - Estimate completed by Burkey
  10. Alley Vacation
    - In Process with Engineer and Solicitor
  11. Hill & George Traffic Patterns –
    - Signs ordered awaiting receipt for Public Works to install.
  12. Storm / Flood Damage
    - Drainage Improvement Study: awaiting FEMA information
    - Brandywine/Lincoln pipe lining rough estimate was \$1.2 million
    - Public Works will be installing larger pipes and additional inlets at Lincoln and Brandywine this summer.
    - All other drainage improvements are on hold.
