- PennDOT Grant is for \$173,995 for LED replacements and other upgrades at 29 intersections.
 - Construction must be complete by May 15, 2022; the expiration is June 30, 2022.
 - TPD is working on design and permitting. Recommend cancelling TPD contract due to lack of PennDOT funding.
