  - A. PA American rate increase

  - A. Berkshire Boulevard Pump Station
  - B. 2020 Capital Project recommendation
7. Streets
  - A. 4<sup>th</sup> Street Extension/Multi-Modal - Tower Health
    - DCED Awarded \$2 Million grant for the project.
    - PADOT has still not announced grant recipients. PADOT has confirmed if the Borough receives a grant they will work with us to incorporate adding in the replacement of the bridge at the YR club, Borough-wide traffic signal improvements, and SWM improvements
    - Separate from the PennDOT MTF grant, PennDOT has provided \$187,022 in funding to complete the bike route and install bike share stations in Wyomissing and West Reading
    - Council conditionally approved the deed of dedication for ROW from Equus for Fourth Street
    - Contract Awarded to Barwis Construction \$1,737,444.
    - Contract is ready for execution

- B. Council conditionally approved transfer of ownership from Equus to the Borough for the pocket park at Penn and Park
  - C. Telecom street cut permits
8. Green Light Go (2019)
    - Contract closed out due to no funding by Penn DOT.
  9. Hydrant Requirements – Building Code/Borough Ordinance Amendment
    - The SALDO amendment was adopted at the March Council meeting. The UCC meeting was tabled at the request of a representative on behalf of the Builder’s Association to allow the association time to review and comment on the amendment
  10. Public Works Facility
    - Estimate completed by Burkey
  11. Traffic studies and stop sign placements along Cleveland Avenue and Lake Avenue
  12. Storm / Flood Damage
    - Drainage Improvement Study: just received 600 pages of FEMA information. We will discuss the report at August meeting.
    - Brandywine/Lincoln pipe lining rough estimate was \$1.2 million
    - Public Works will be installing larger pipes and additional inlets at Lincoln and Brandywine this summer.
    - All other drainage improvements are on hold.
