



## BOROUGH OF WYOMISSING POLICE DEPARTMENT

### 5K RUN MAP:

The Borough of Wyomissing is blessed to have approximately 350 acres of parklands that are enjoyed by not only Borough residents but guests as well. It is because of these parklands, the Borough gets many requests to hold special events to include various 5k runs that benefit a variety of non-profit organizations. The vast majority of these events both begin and end at the Stone House, the course then traverses the parklands. The Borough is happy that so many organizations want to make Wyomissing the destination for their event, however the Borough has decided to make some changes to the course that will be utilized by those organizations. Instead of beginning the race on Parkside Drive South and ending on Parkside Drive North, the race will both begin and end on Parkside Drive South. By making this change, we are hoping to limit the negative effects of traffic and parking restrictions on those residents that live in the area of the Stone House, while maintaining a pleasant course for those organizations wishing to hold their event here in Wyomissing. A map of the course can be seen here but the route is as follows:

Parkside Drive South to Old Mill Rd.  
Old Mill Rd. to Old Wyomissing Rd.  
Old Wyomissing Rd. to the Park Barn.  
Through the Pine Forrest.  
Pine Forrest to Summit Trail.  
Summit Trail to High Rd.  
High Rd. to Old Lauers Ln.  
Old Lauers Ln to Cherry Ln. Trail  
Cherry Ln. Trail to Summit Trail.  
Summit Trail to High Rd.  
High Rd. to Old Mill Rd.  
Old Mill Rd to Parkside Drive South.  
Parkside Drive South to end.

For all those organizations that wish to hold their event, this is the designated route, any alteration will be at the discretion of Borough Council. A Special Event Permit continues to need to be completed and submitted 60 days prior to the event for approval.
